

## *Troyer's Sparrow-resistant Bluebird House and Pole*



Step 1) Pound the post into the ground. Make sure the large hole (used for mounting the house to the pole) is at the top of the pole.



Step 2) Fasten the cable clamp onto the pole. Slide the clamp over the top of pole and stop around 16" Tighten the bolt onto the pole.

**VERY IMPORTANT!** The pole guard dangles from the cable clamp, thus allowing the pole guard to wobble. This wobble action has been proven to deter raccoons.



Step 3) Slide the pole guard over the top of the pole. There is a hole in the top of the pole guard. Align the hole in the pole guard with the pole and slip the pole guard down on to the cable clamp.



Step 4) Attach the house to the pole. Remove the Stainless steel wing nut from the bolt found on the back side of the house. Insert the stem of the bolt thru the hole in the pole, and thread the wing nut back on to the bolt. Finger tighten the wing nut.
