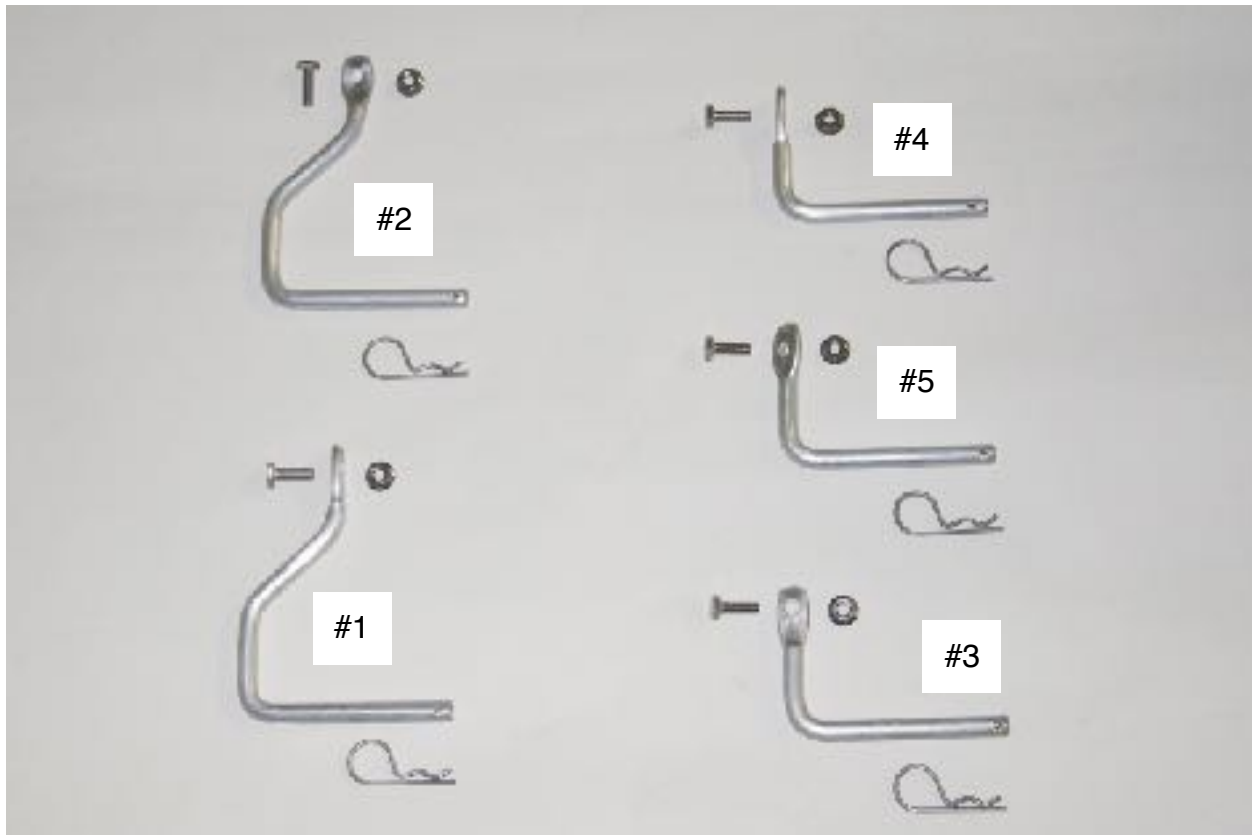


Gourd Mounting Arms®



#1 Vertical 90 GMA. Ideal for SuperGourds, Excluder Gourds and natural gourds. The gourds entrance hole will face out and away from the pole.

#2 Vertical Straight GMA. Ideal for SuperGourds, Excluder Gourds and natural gourds. The gourds entrance hole is directly below the gourd-hanging arm

#3 Horizontal Straight GMA. Ideal for All Troyer Gourds. The gourds entrance hole faces out and away from the pole.

#4 Horizontal 90 GMA Ideal for All Troyer Gourds. The gourds entrance hole is directly below the gourd-hanging arm.

#5 Horizontal 45 GMA Ideal for All Troyer Gourds. The gourds entrance hole is 45° below the gourd-hanging arm.

Horizontal Style GMA's are more versatile than vertical style. You can always drill a vertical-hung gourd to accommodate a horizontal GMA, but not vise-versa.

Gourd Mounting Arms®

Step 1) Insert one of your 1/4" x 20 x 3/4" bolts into the pre punched hole of the GMA.



Step 2) Choose where you would like to mount the gourd by picking one of the many pre punched holes on the arms or rings.



Step 3) Insert the bolt into the hole. Attach the nut to the bolt. Tighten the bolt using a 7/16" box wrench.



Step 4) Your gourd may need to have its hanging hole enlarged. Use a 3/8" drill bit to enlarge the gourds hanging hole.

Step 5) Slide the gourd onto the mounting arm, and insert your hitch pin into the small drilled hole found at the end of the GMA. This will keep your gourd from sliding off.



NOTE: Horizontal 45 should be used in the center position on the Super System angle arms. See circle above.
